The University of Melbourne

There are three options to consider

Option 1: Chancellor's Scholarship

COURSE

Chancellor's Scholars are guaranteed entry into the Doctor of Medicine providing they meet selection criteria, <https://bit.ly/2Kz8r3Z>

Choose one of the following degrees for your undergraduate program:

- Bachelor of Science, <https://bit.ly/2tjM1dw>
- Bachelor of Biomedicine, <https://bit.ly/2H5BKZU>

SELECTION CRITERIA - BACHELOR

- ATAR – raw score of 99.9 (Indigenous – 90).
- Meet prerequisites for chosen Bachelor degree.

SELECTION CRITERIA - MD

- Multi Mini Interview
- Pass all subjects on the first attempt in the undergraduate degree
- Note: The GAMSAT isn't used for entry into the MD for Chancellor's Scholars if they meet the selection criteria.

HOW TO APPLY

List the Bachelor of Science (Chancellor's Scholars) and/or the Bachelor of Biomedicine (Chancellor's Scholars) in your VTAC preferences.

Option 2: Undergraduate/Graduate

COURSE

High achievers may be able to secure guaranteed entry into the Doctor of Medicine. Choose one of the following course options

SELECTION CRITERIA - BACHELOR

- ATAR: 99 – 99.85 (raw)
- Meet prerequisites for chosen degree

SELECTION CRITERIA - MD

- Pass all subjects on the first attempt in the undergraduate degree
- Maintain a weighted average mark of 75%
- Note: The GAMSAT isn't used for entry into the MD for high achievers who meet the selection criteria.

List the Bachelor of Science and/or the Bachelor of Biomedicine in your VTAC preferences.

Option 3: Graduate Entry

OVERVIEW

Students studying at any university can apply to the four-year Doctor of Medicine at The University of Melbourne.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Completion of an undergraduate degree in any discipline – must contain certain subjects
- Grade point average of the undergraduate degree
- GAMSAT
- Multi mini interview

HOW TO APPLY

You will need to complete an undergraduate degree before you can apply for the Doctor of Medicine.

La Trobe University and The University of Melbourne

La Trobe and the University of Melbourne has a joint medical program for applicants with regional/rural backgrounds.

OVERVIEW

Students complete the three-year Bachelor of Biomedicine (Medical) at the La Trobe Bendigo or Albury-Wodonga campus, <https://bit.ly/2TgA9HO>

Depending on grades, students may then be able to transfer into the Doctor of Medicine at University of Melbourne, Shepparton campus.

SELECTION CRITERIA - BACHELOR

- Raw ATAR of 85+
- Meet prerequisites: minimum study score of 30 in English (EAL) or 25 in English (any other).
- Multi mini interview (selected applicants)

SELECTION CRITERIA - MD

- Weighted average mark of at least 75 in the Bachelor degree.

HOW TO APPLY

List the Bachelor of Biomedicine (Medical) in your VTAC preferences.

Deakin University

Deakin has graduate entry Medicine.

OVERVIEW

Students studying at any university can apply to the four-year Doctor of Medicine at Deakin University, Geelong Waurm Ponds <https://bit.ly/2Xv5z08>

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Grade point average of an undergraduate degree
- GAMSAT
- Interview

Note: applicants may receive adjustment points for factors such as completing a degree at Deakin, undertaking 12-months of clinical experience in a health profession such as speech pathology or dietetics, or have a rural/regional background

You will need to complete an undergraduate degree before you can apply for the Doctor of Medicine.
