NSW/ACT APPLICATIONS

TO DO

Initial course application: Put in up to 5 course preferences. You can change your preferences (add/delete/reorder) later until certain dates.

Courses- extra requirements: You have made of list of what you need to do for courses that have additional selection criteria other than just the ATAR (e.g., interviews, forms, folios, auditions, compulsory info sessions).

Educational Access Scheme (EAS) application: Completed your application if you are eligible for any categories. Posted off and/or uploaded any supporting statements or other documentation required by UAC.

School's Recommendation Scheme (SRS): Have applied for early entry (if applicable). Finalise your preferences by Sunday 10 November.

Equity Scholarship (ES) application: Completed your online application. Posted off/uploaded any supporting statements or other documentation required by UAC.

Processing fee: You have paid the one-off \$70 processing fee.

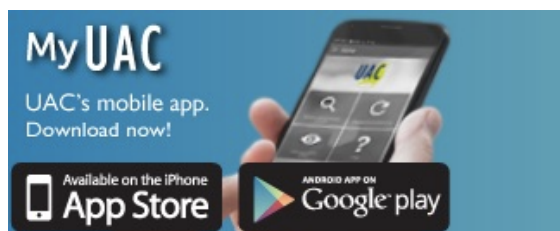

Step 1: Create a UAC account & apply for courses

1. Go to www.uac.edu.au/
2. Click on Undergraduate Applicants.
3. Click on 'Your Application' in the red box then click on the red box that says 'Apply Now'.
4. Click on 'start your application'.
5. Fill out each section. The four-digit pin is the first four digits of your birthdate (e.g., 2nd of February = 0202).
6. Download and print off the confirmation application package - this will list your UAC number.



Step 2: Pay Processing Fee

1. Once you complete your course application in Step 1, you will have the option of paying online.
2. If you would like to pay later, you can select BPay or Bill Pay and download an invoice with your confirmation application package.
3. You can pay the one-off \$70 processing fee at the post office or via BPay.

Step 3: Complete EAS

1. Work out if you are eligible for any categories by exploring the Educational Access Schemes site- www.uac.edu.au/eas/
2. Download and print the 2020 Educational Access Schemes Booklet
3. Apply for any categories you may be eligible for via the online portal and organise the evidence needed.
4. Upload evidence required to UAC by Friday 29 November.

Step 4: Complete Scholarships

1. Read about the scholarship application process and required evidence here- www.uac.edu.au/equity/
2. Hover your mouse over the 'Apply or Login' button then click on 'Equity Scholarships – application and offers', then click 'Start your Application'.
3. Work through each step and click submit.
4. Download and print the confirmation package, which will list any evidence you are required to provide and post to UAC or upload to the website. This will also list your ES code.
5. Complete this by Sunday 15 December.

VTAC Application Checklist

TO DO

Registration: Created a VTAC Account

Initial course application: Put in up to 8 course preferences. You can change your preferences (add/delete/reorder) until Dec. 14 October (FOR MOST COURSES).

Courses- extra requirements: You have made of list of what you need to do for courses that have additional selection criteria other than just the ATAR (i.e., interviews, forms, folios, auditions, compulsory info sessions).

SEAS application: Completed your application, making sure you have checked your eligibility for each of the four categories. Supplied any supporting statements or other documentation required by VTAC.

Scholarship application: Completed your application. Supplied any supporting statements or other documentation required by VTAC.

Application fee: You have paid the processing fee of \$39.

Personal Statement Form: Only for some courses. Check the selection criteria for each course via the VTAC site.

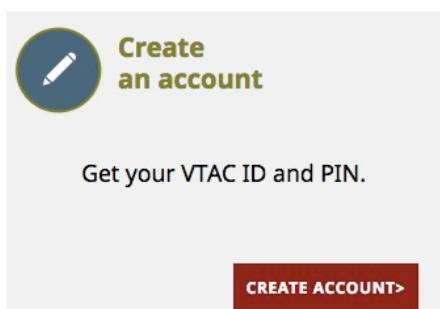

ALL THINGS VTAC

Step 1: Create a VTAC Account

Work through the steps. You will need your VCAA ID number and you can make up your own 4-digit pin. Video on how to create your account -

Step 2: Apply for courses

1. Go to www.vtac.edu.au/
2. Click on Login with your ID and Pin and enter your VTAC ID and Pin (this has been emailed to you).
3. Select the course application link
4. Work through the steps

Step 3: Pay Processing Fee

1. Login to your VTAC Account
2. Select the payment link
3. Pay the one-off \$39 processing fee by Monday 9 December.

Step 4: Apply for SEAS

1. Work out your eligibility for any of the four categories by exploring the VTAC SEAS (Special Entry Access Scheme) site- <https://bit.ly/1PG8zl4>
2. Login to your VTAC Account
3. Click on the SEAS link and apply for any of the 4 categories that you are eligible for.
4. Organise supporting statements and any other required documentation and post them with the SEAS document cover letter to VTAC by 11 October or upload directly to the website.

Step 5: Apply for Scholarships

2. Login to your VTAC Account
3. Click on the scholarships link and work through the steps.
4. Organise supporting statements and any other required documentation and post them with the Scholarship document cover letter to VTAC by 11 October or upload directly to the website.
